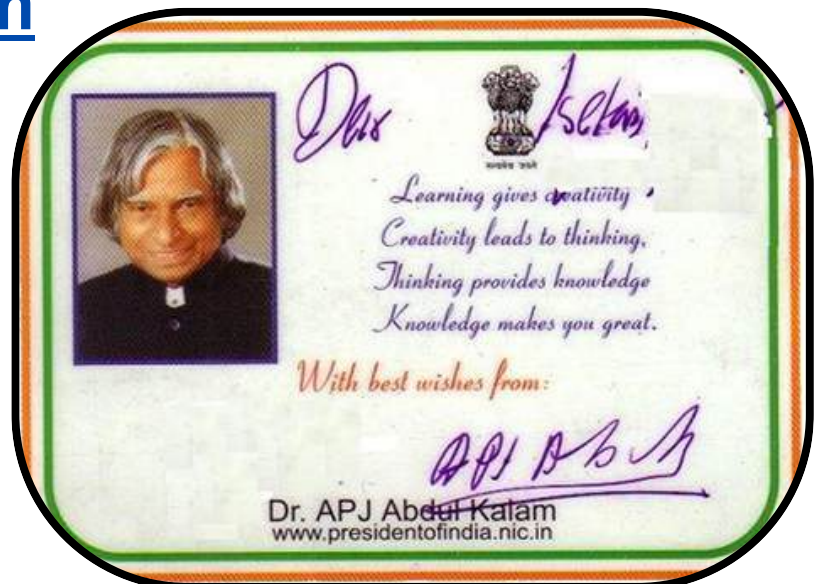

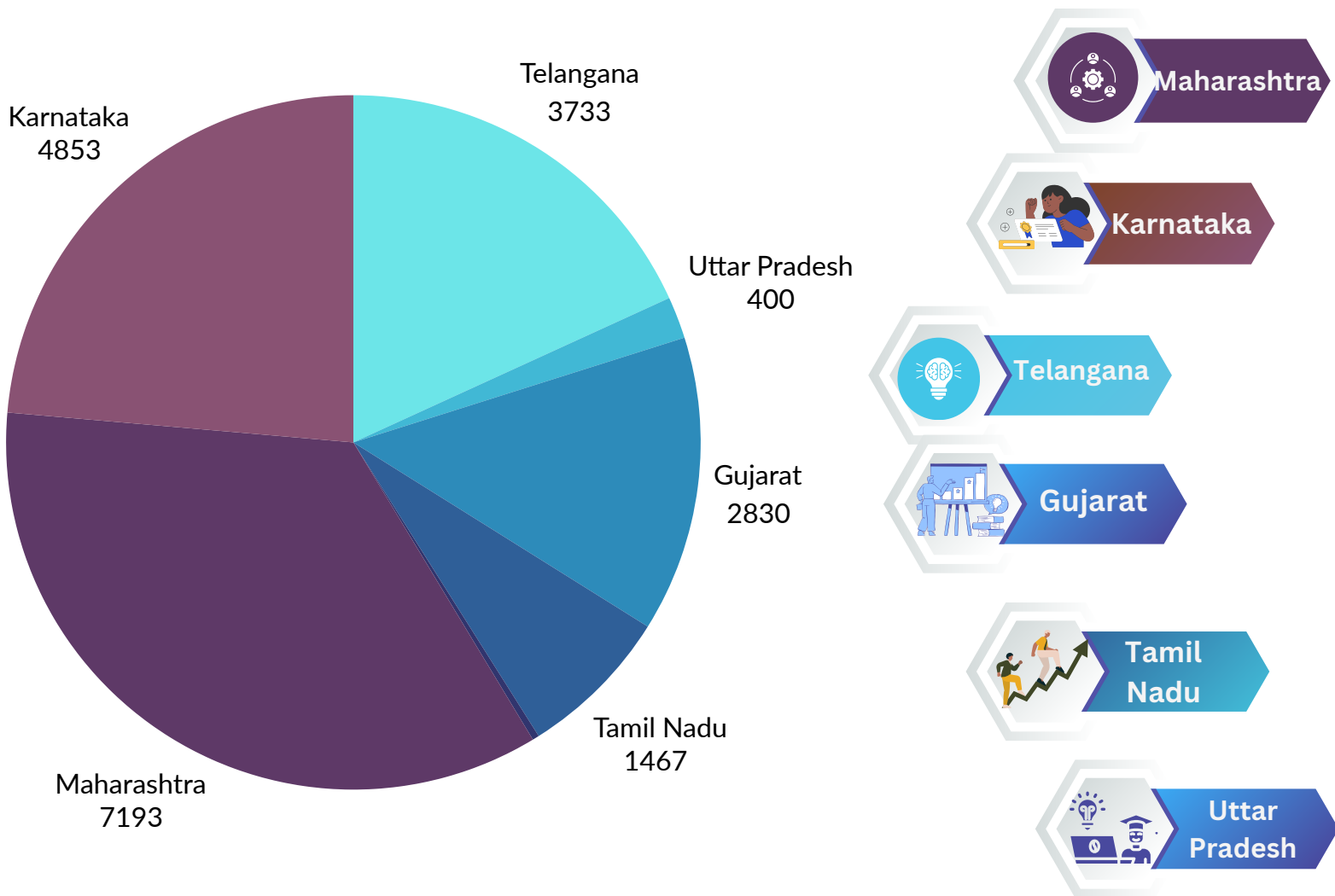

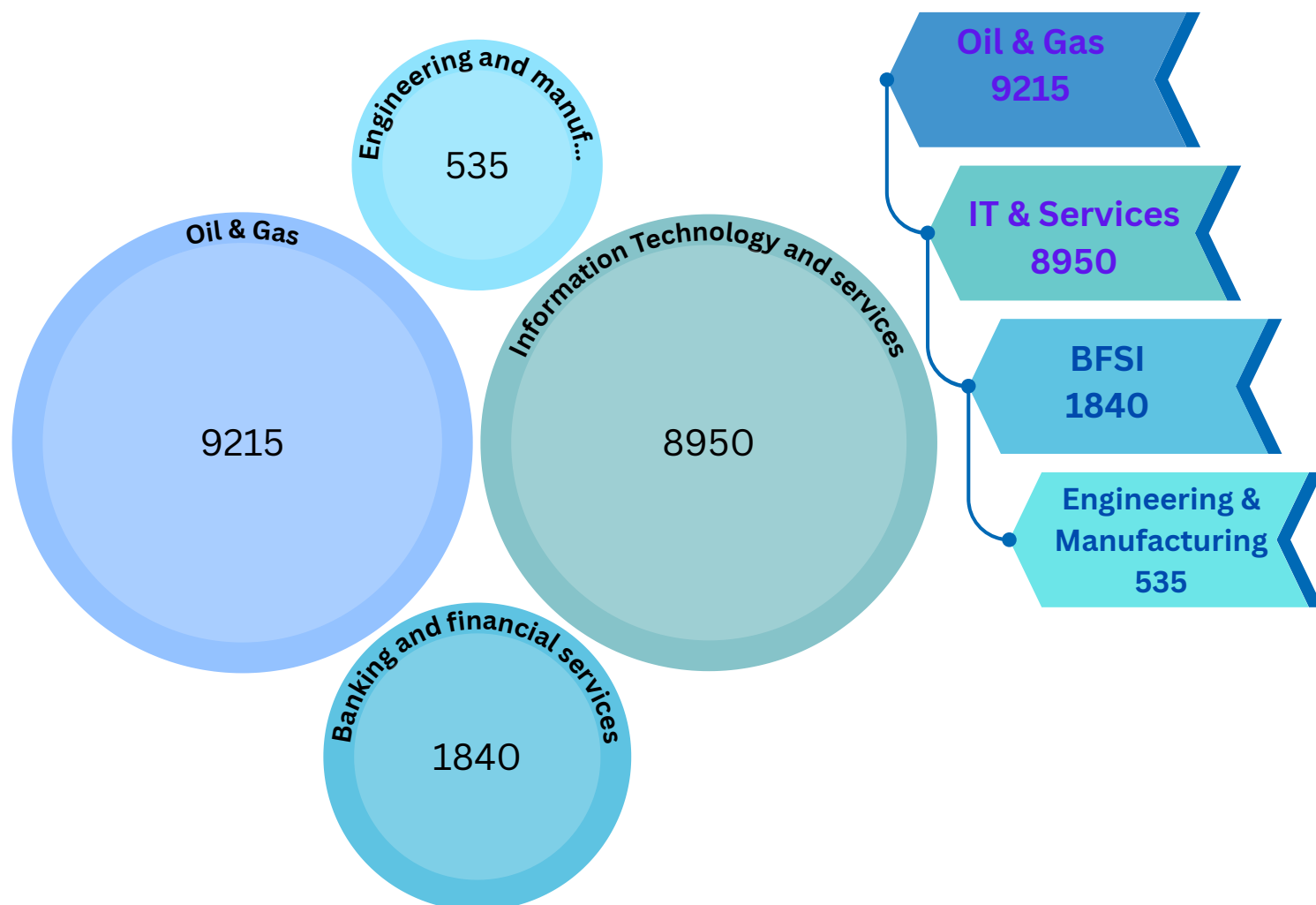
State wise beneficiaries

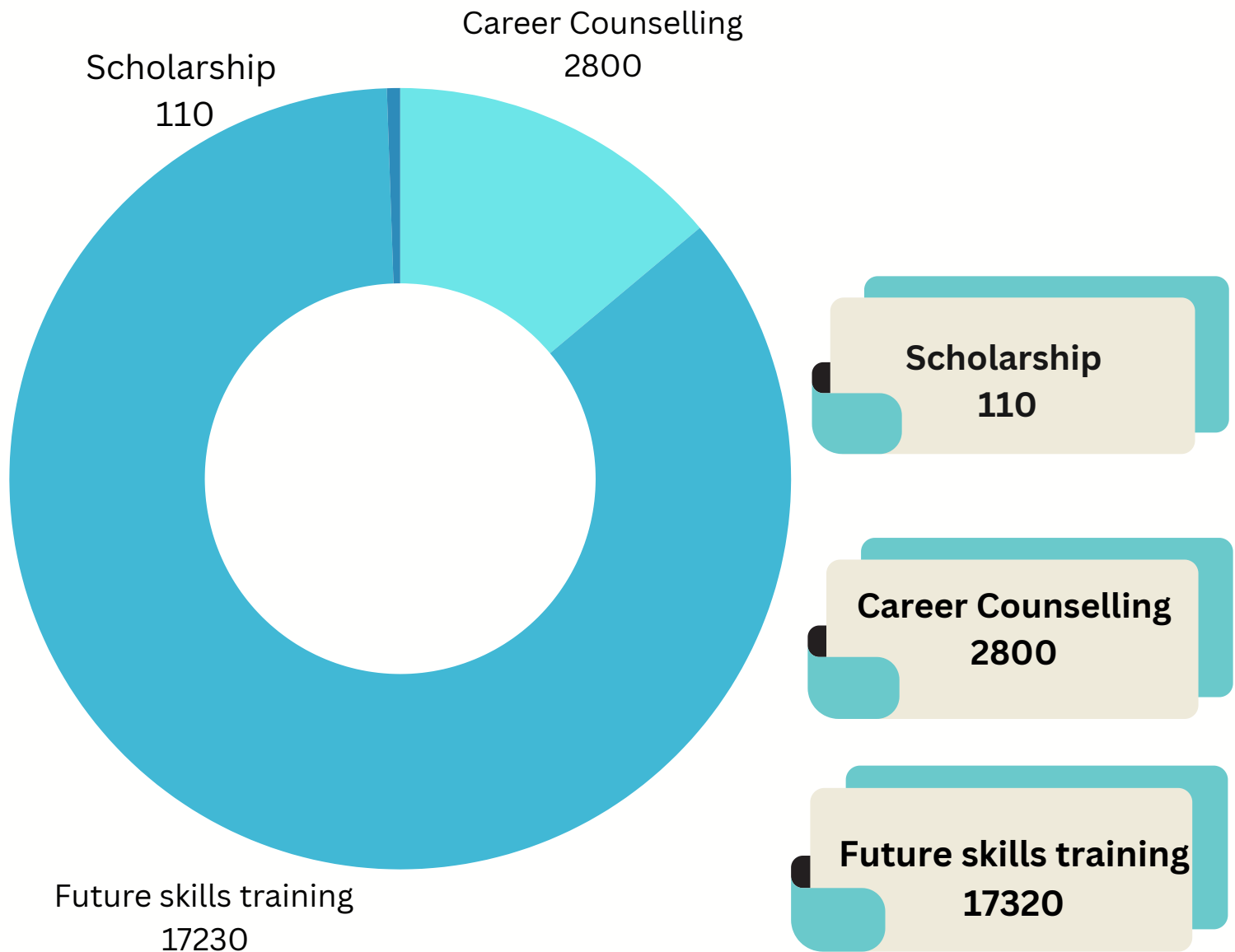
In the fiscal year 2023–24, significant progress was made in reaching beneficiaries across various states in India. Maharashtra led with 7,193 beneficiaries impacted, followed by Karnataka with 4,853, and Telangana with 3,733. Gujarat saw 3,830 beneficiaries benefiting from the initiatives, while Tamil Nadu recorded 1,467. Uttar Pradesh had a comparatively smaller impact, with 400 beneficiaries reached. These numbers highlight the widespread reach of the program, showcasing its positive influence on communities across multiple states in India during this period.

Sector wise Beneficiaries Impacted



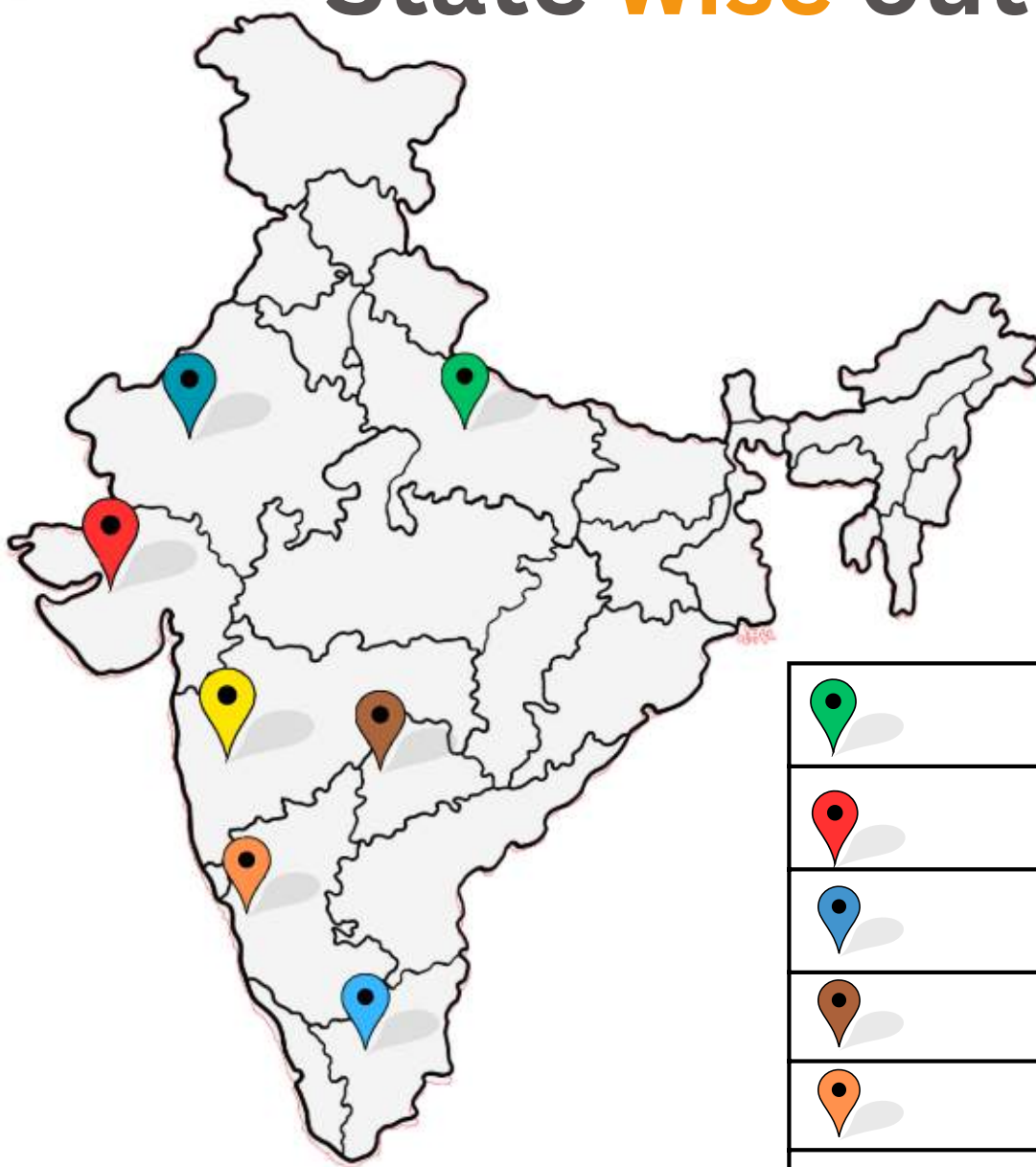

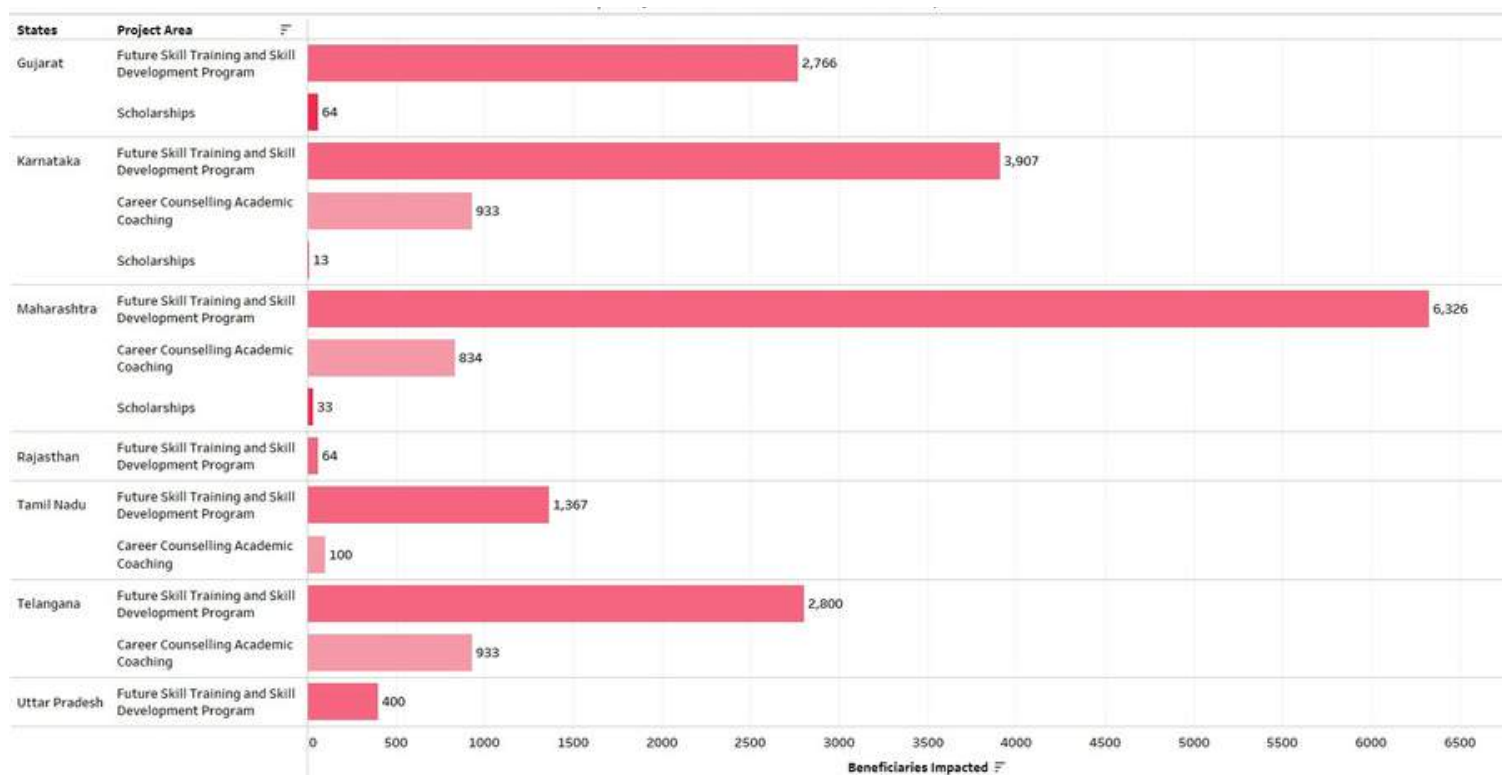
State wise outreach



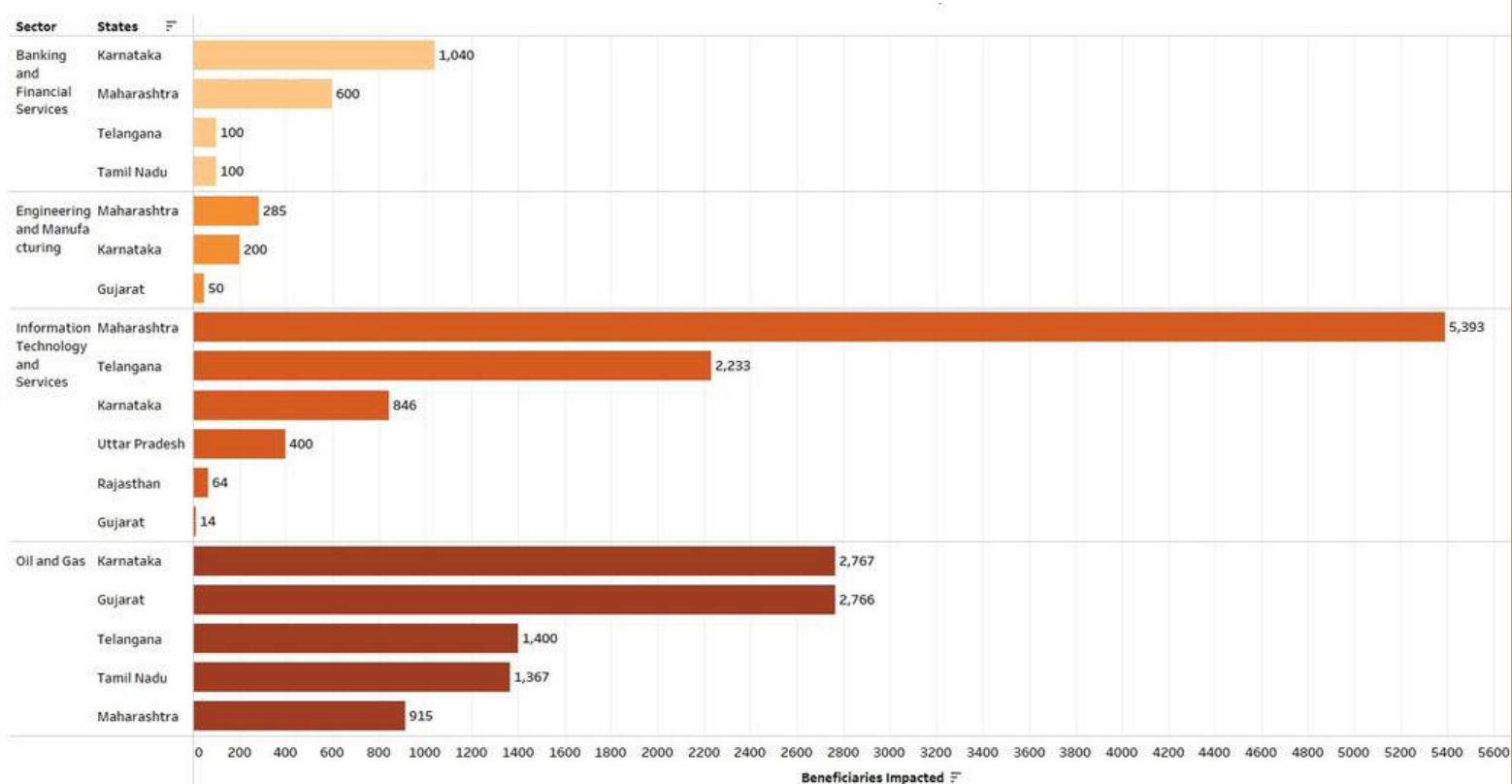

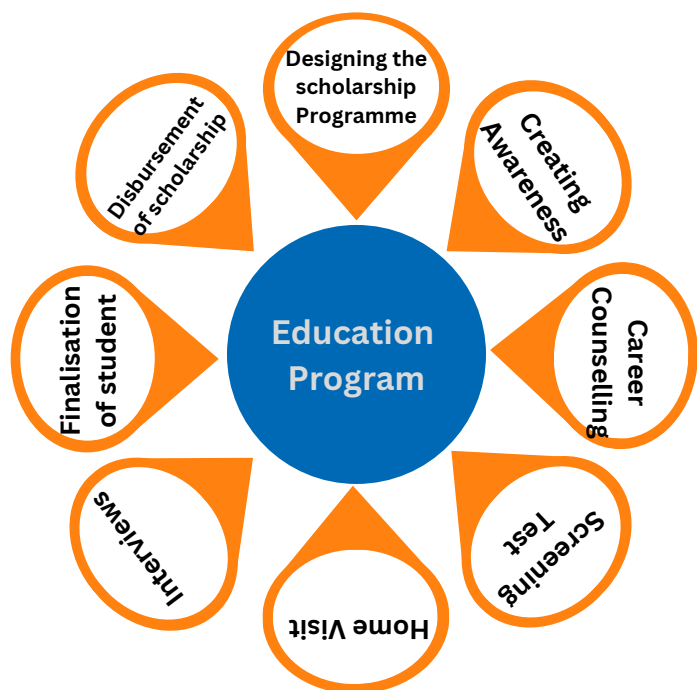

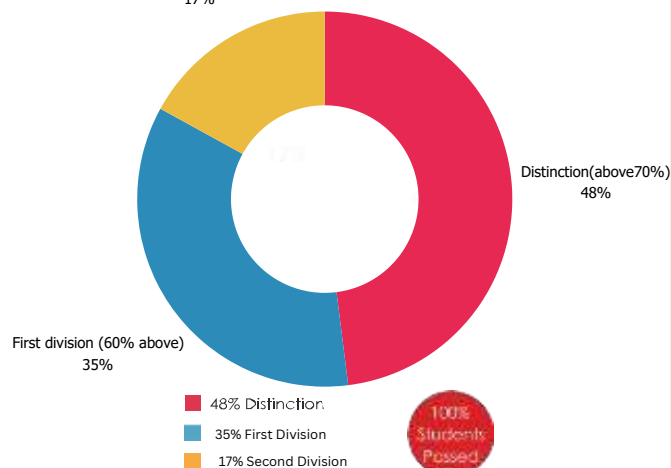
